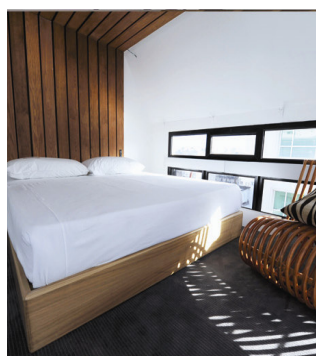

HOW TO GET THERE

FROM THE AIRPORT

Take a Remisse (private taxi) "Manuel Tienda Leon" to the Hotel a "Manuel Tienda Leon" bus to Buenos Aires Center. Just 15 minutes away from the "Jorge Newberry" Local Airport.
