HOW TO GET THERE

FROM THE AIRPORT

From the Barajas Airport, you may take a taxi or opt for the underground train, the Metro. If taking the Metro, take Line 8 (the pink line, towards Nuevos Ministerios) to the Nuevos Ministerios stop. There, you will connect with Line 10 (the dark blue line, towards Puerta del Sur), and get off at the Alonso Martínez stop. Finally, take Line 5 (the green line towards Casa de Campo) until you come to the Opera stop.

GETTING AROUND THE CITY ON PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Mario is very close to the Puerta del Sol, which has a stop for bus lines 10, 151 and 12. These three lines cover virtually the entire city.
