## HOW TO GET THERE

### FROM THE AIRPORT

If you arrive by plane, you may either take a taxi, which will leave you just 50 metres from the hotel, or the bus, getting off at the Gran Vía/Capilla Real stop. There you will be approximately 250 metres from the hotel. There is a scheduled bus for every arriving flight.

### BY CAR

Room Mate Migueletes is located in a historic quarter, no private car access, thus the hotel cannot be accessed by car. You may park car park (at the Plaza Puerta Real). For further information on how to arrive by car, please visit our website.

### GETTING AROUND THE CITY ON PUBLIC TRANSPORT

You may take a taxi or a bus (Line 3 or 33) which will leave you at the La Capilla Real stop, at Gran Vía street, which is just 400 metres from the hotel.
