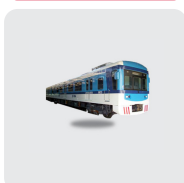


PLAIN

Just 25 minutes away by car from the Ministro Pistarini International Airport (Ezeiza International Airport) along the Ricchieri - 25 de Mayo Highway. Take a Remisse (private taxi) "Manuel Tienda Leon" to the Hotel a "Manuel Tienda Leon" bus to Buenos Aires Center. Just 15 minutes away from the "Jorge Newberry" Local Airport.
