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## NEARBY POINTS OF INTEREST:

Rambla de Catalunya: 1 min. (50 mts.)  
Passeig de Gràcia: 1 min. (50 mts.)  
Gaudi's Casa Batlló: 2 min. (100 m.)  
Rambla de les Flors: 4 min. (200 m.)  
Sagrada Familia Cathedral: 12 min. (1 km.)  
Barri Gòtic: 8 min. (400 m.)  
Barcelona Cathedral: 6 min. (300 m.)  
Gaudi's Güell Park: 15 min. (1.5 km.)  
Magic Fountain of Montjuïc: 12 min. (1 km.)  
Paseo Marítimo promenade – Beach: 12 min. (1 km.)  
Barcelona Exhibition Grounds and Conference Centre: 5 min. by car or public transit (1 km.)  
Barcelona Nord bus station, with transfer to Girona airport, 5 min. by car or public transit (800 m.)  
Sants railway station (connects with AVE): 3 min. by car or public transit (800 m.)  
Cruise ship terminal and seaport: 3 min. by car or public transit (500 m.)  
Barcelona airport: 10 min. by car or bus (5 km.)



AIR PLANE

Barcelona airport: Final stop of AEROBUS shuttle at plaça de Catalunya, 3 min. walk from the hotel or direct access via metro line 3 (green line) at Diagonal station.

Gerona airport: Transfer to the city on BARCELONABUS shuttle with final stop at the Barcelona Nord bus station and then on to the hotel by metro.



TRAIN



You can reach the Sants train station by regional train or on the high-speed AVE, then continue to the hotel by metro or a 10-minute walk.



CAR

Entering the city on Diagonal Avenue from highway A-2, continue in the centre lane of Diagonal Avenue until you get to plaça Francesc Macià. From there, stay in the right lane of the same avenue until you come to carrer Muntaner on the right and then turn left. Now you're on my street: carrer Roselló.

Entering the city on Ronda Litoral (A-7), if you're coming from the Tarragona area, take exit 21 onto passeig de Colom, then turn left onto via Laietana. Go straight on, turn left onto carrer Mallorca, then right onto Muntaner until you come to carrer Roselló.

Entering the city on Ronda Litoral (A-7), if you're coming from France, take exit 22 then continue until you get to via Laietana. From there, follow the same directions to my place given above.

Entering on the Gran Vía, if you're coming from Castelldefels, continue straight on the Gran Vía, then turn left onto carrer Muntaner until you get to carrer Roselló.



DON'T MISS:

Go shopping at the trendiest shops on passeig de Gràcia. Relax at some of the terrace bars on Rambla de Catalunya: have a couple of tapas and a beer.

Get to know (and love!) the Gaudí "modernist route": La Pedrera, Casa Batllò, Sagrada Família and Guëll Park. Stroll in any direction through the narrow streets of the Barri Gòtic.

Have a good paella in the fishermen's district of La Barceloneta and take a walk on the promenade along the Mediterranean Sea.

Try a night on the town in the Raval district or the Eixample.

Enjoy the city's different festivals, like the Festa de Gràcia, Festes de La Mercè, Sonar or the party on the night of Sant Joan.

Go see a football match at Camp Nou.

Visit some of the city's best museums, such as the Picasso museum, the Contemporary Art museum or the Science museum.

Take in a panoramic view of the city from some of its hills, such as Montjuïc or Tibidabo.

Enjoy the colourful visual and musical spectacle of the Magic Fountain of Montjuïc.

Take a motorcycle or scooter ride through the narrow street of the city centre and visit any number of interesting places.
