



## BY PLANE



You can take either a taxi, which will leave you at the door of the Hotel, or a **number 23** bus, which has a stop at the Royal Chapel and passes in front of the hotel. There is a bus programmed to coincide with each arriving flight.



## BY TRAIN

The train stops at the Granada **RENFE station**. From there you can take a taxi to the hotel.

## BY BUS



You can take a taxi or a bus (**# 3 or 33**) which will drop you off at the **Capilla Real** stop.



## BY CAR

You can get to our hotel by car and use our private parking, having previously reserved a space.

On the **Granada Ring Road**, take exit 131 "Granada, Parque de las Ciencias, Palacio de Congresos, Armilla" and continue in the direction of **Centro-Parque de las Ciencias**. You will pass a roundabout with the Hiperluz lamp outlet, and then another roundabout with the Parque de las Ciencias. Continue heading towards Sierra Nevada-Centro and you will go through a tunnel. You will arrive at the Palacio de Congresos (a green marble building to your left), continue heading in the direction **Centro-Alhambra**. Go straight on and take the bridge over the Genil River, follow the signs marked "Centro". You will pass a Mercadona supermarket on your left and, then, a Corte Inglés department store on your right. Continue until you get to the end of the Avenue and at the junction, on your right, you will see the Post Office building (Correos), turn right (Calle Angel Ganivet), continue until you get to the end of this street and then turn left and go up Calle San Matías. At the end of that street, turn right and keep going along **Calle Pavaneras** until you get to Plaza Fortuny, where you will find the hotel.

If you have not been able to reserve a space in our parking lot, follow the instructions above until you get to the Corte Inglés. The **Plaza Puerta Real** public parking is reached by turning right at the next traffic lights, under the plaza. We have a special price agreed for our guests at this parking. The hotel is about 200 m away.
